TO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF MANITOBA:

These are the reasons for this petition:

- 1. The Provincial Government's changes to Crown Lands regulations will make life harder and more expensive for Manitoba producers.
- 2. The changes opened the market to out-of-province corporate renters by removing the requirement that renters do the work on the land which will make it easier for big corporations to outbid the next generation of producers.
- 3. The Provincial Government reduced leases from 35 years to 15 years.
- 4. The reduction in lease years will not only impact a producer's ability to hold onto their land, it will also disincentivize young producers from starting up.
- 5. The Provincial Government also removed the ability to transfer units, making it impossible for producers to coordinate transfer of their leases when they sell their private land.
- 6. Crown Lands' rents have increased by 300-400% and have put many producers at risk of losing their farm.
- 7. Over the last two years, hundreds of producers have held town halls, sent letters and emails, and made hundreds of phone calls advocating against the changes by the Provincial Government.
- 8. Manitoba producers need predictable and affordable access to Crown land leases.

We petition the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba as follows:

To urge the Provincial Government to reverse its changes to Crown land leases to ensure stability and security for Manitoba producers and the economy.
